



2023 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Last year a total of \$75,000 was awarded to talented recipients.

Award eligibility:

Any high school senior who is the child of a current, active, full-time, and permanent member of the LAPD who has been accepted to an accredited college or university.

The merit-based scholarships are awarded based primarily upon academic achievement. Extra-curricular activities and accomplishments as well as good character may also be considered.

Each applicant will be required to submit two letters of recommendation, one of which must be written and submitted by a teacher, counselor, or school administrator. The second letter of recommendation may be submitted by any adult not related to the applicant who has knowledge of the applicant's character, activities, and achievements. Current official transcripts are also required.

The application period opens February 1, 2023, and closes on March 31, 2023. All materials must be received in the Memorial Foundation office or postmarked on or prior to March 31, 2023.

Scholarship Application – 2023

Application period February 1, 2023-March 31, 2023

The Los Angeles Police Memorial Foundation Awards multiple merit-based Scholarships annually. The most important factor considered is academic achievement. Other criteria including personal character, extracurricular activities, and community service may be considered.

Instructions To Applicant:

1. **Eligibility:** Applications will only be considered from current high school seniors, who are dependents of full-time, active sworn officers and civilian employees, who will enroll at a fully accredited four-year college or university in the Fall 2023 term. (Does not include children of retired employees, part-time employees, or Reserve Officers.)
2. Complete pages 1-3 of the attached Application form. Please print clearly or type.
3. Arrange for your most recent **official** high school transcript to be sent to the address below. *Provide a copy of the “Instructions to School Registrar” when requesting your school transcripts.*
4. Obtain and submit two letters of recommendation. If necessary, provide a copy of the “Instructions Regarding Letters of Recommendation” to each person writing one of the two letters required. Remember that at least one letter must come from a teacher or counselor, and **neither may be written by a relative.** You should give both of them a stamped envelope addressed to the location below, and postmarked no later than **March 31, 2023.**
5. **In order to be considered, the application must contain all requested material (all 3 pages of the application, official transcript and letters of recommendation).** In the event clarification or assistance is needed please contact the memorial Foundation at (323)276-5970 or info@lapmf.org.
6. Applications forms, transcripts and letters of recommendation must be postmarked no later than **March 31, 2023. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Instructions for Letters of Recommendation

The Los Angeles Police Memorial Foundation annually awards multiple college scholarships. Current high school seniors, who are dependents of full-time, active sworn officers and civilian employees who will enroll at a fully accredited four-year college or university for the Fall 2023 term are eligible to apply.

These are strictly merit scholarships. The single most important factor is academic achievement. Other criteria, including personal character, extracurricular accomplishments, and community service may be considered.

To assist in the difficult task of choosing winners, the selection committee requires two letters of recommendation. One must be from a teacher, counselor or school administrator, and neither may be written by a relative.

Instructions to School Registrar

The Los Angeles Police Memorial Foundation annually awards multiple college scholarships. Current high school seniors, who are dependents of full-time, active sworn officers and civilian employees who will enroll at a fully accredited four-year college or university for the Fall 2023 term are eligible to apply.

In order for the Memorial Foundation to consider an application, a sealed, official transcript containing a recordation of enrollment status, a listing of completed classes and academic performance (grades and grade point average) is required. Therefore, we are requesting that each student provide the most recent official high school transcript.

The **deadline** for application acceptance is **March 31, 2023**. Materials (all pages of the application form, transcript and letters of recommendation must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2022. Please send the sealed official transcript directly to the following:
